During the month of September the new driving simulator had been delivered, assembled, and made operational. In addition, the Training Division submitted a grant application to PGIT for ½ the cost of the simulator, and the application was approved for \$3,600, (½ of cost). Next, an ammonia awareness class for first responders was taught on 3 separate days for SMFR's hazmat techs. Crews were also brought into the training room, by the Chief and D/C Bounds, to set up their required State of Florida EMT accounts. Also, there was a Carbon Dioxide for 1st Responders class hosted 1 day at SMFR for hazmat and shift personnel. Carbon Dioxide displaces oxygen and has recently been determined a toxin, and it can be found in many businesses and some homes. Next, the Field Training Officers ran personnel through the hazmat-truck & trailer recertification process, and the aerial recertification process. Lastly, October will be Fire Prevention Month, the Prevention Division and Engine Companies will be heading to the schools to teach fire safety.
