Fire / EMS Report:

The month of May proved to be another busy month for our division. We completed the quarterly promotional process with the final 3 personnel. We also completed a LODD drill at the Oneco Plaza strip mall. Crews arrived on scene of a simulated large fire and began aggressive interior operations. When crews were trapped by a failed roof system our RIC teams were deployed and removed them from the building. EMS was able to attend some of the drills, as well our training was used in regional certification process by ECC, as a live dispatcher was present and graded by their actions. We also hosted an In-House training session with Wells Fargo where a financial advisor discussed retirement options. This session was a huge success thanks to D/C Bounds. Crews also continued to renew their Fire & EMS certificates by completing Target Solutions assigned classes. The ALS / BLS testing was placed on hold for this quarter and will be completed in June. Finally this month crews completed a tour of the Pierce manufacturing plant. Crews were show fire protection systems and hazards present at this facility. Sometime in July we will be completing a confined space entry at this facility with a date TBA.

Special Operations Report:

This month was an active month for personnel. The special operations team reviewed gasoline tanker emergencies in a class that was presented in conjunction with the Tampa Bay Local Emergency Planning Committee. Retired Battalion Chief Leigh Hollins instructed three sessions with 66 students from the region from Sarasota to the Clearwater area attending. Each student received continuing education credit for 3 hours from the Florida State Fire College. Crews participated in a PIA for the 2 incidents at Port Manatee, Sulfur fires. Lessons learned were shared by all agencies. We worked with Halliburton a company in Texas on a possible drone program for there overseas operations.

Miscellaneous:

Captain Thayer set-up 3 public CPR classes for the month of June.

Captain Bloski continues to work with Fire Prevention on Hazardous Materials occupancy during the annual inspection process to ensure compliance of state regulations.

Captain Bloski is working with the Manatee County Medical group on obtaining a grant for new radiological meters.

Captain Thayer is working with DOF & MTC to get our personnel the state certificate on safety officers. A number of live fire evaluations must be completed.
