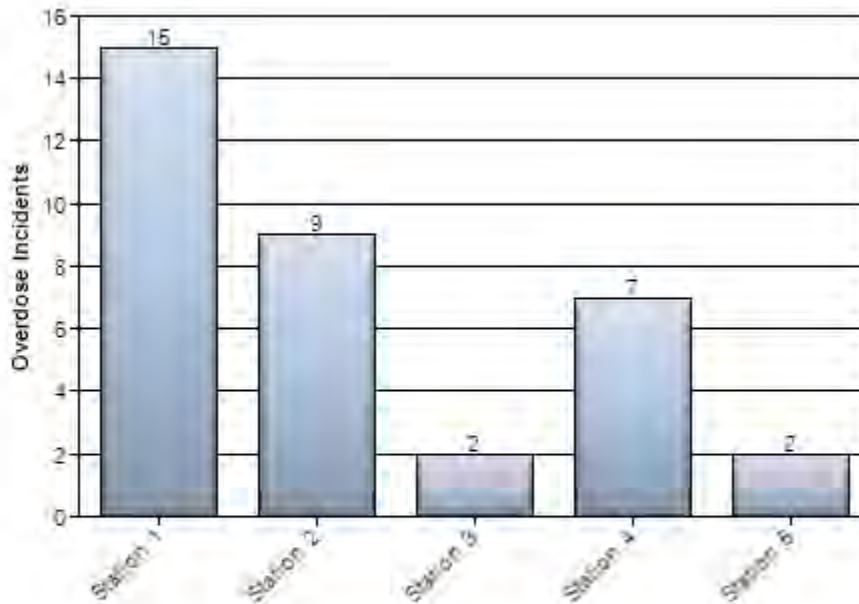

Alarm Date between 2020-11-01 and 2020-12-01



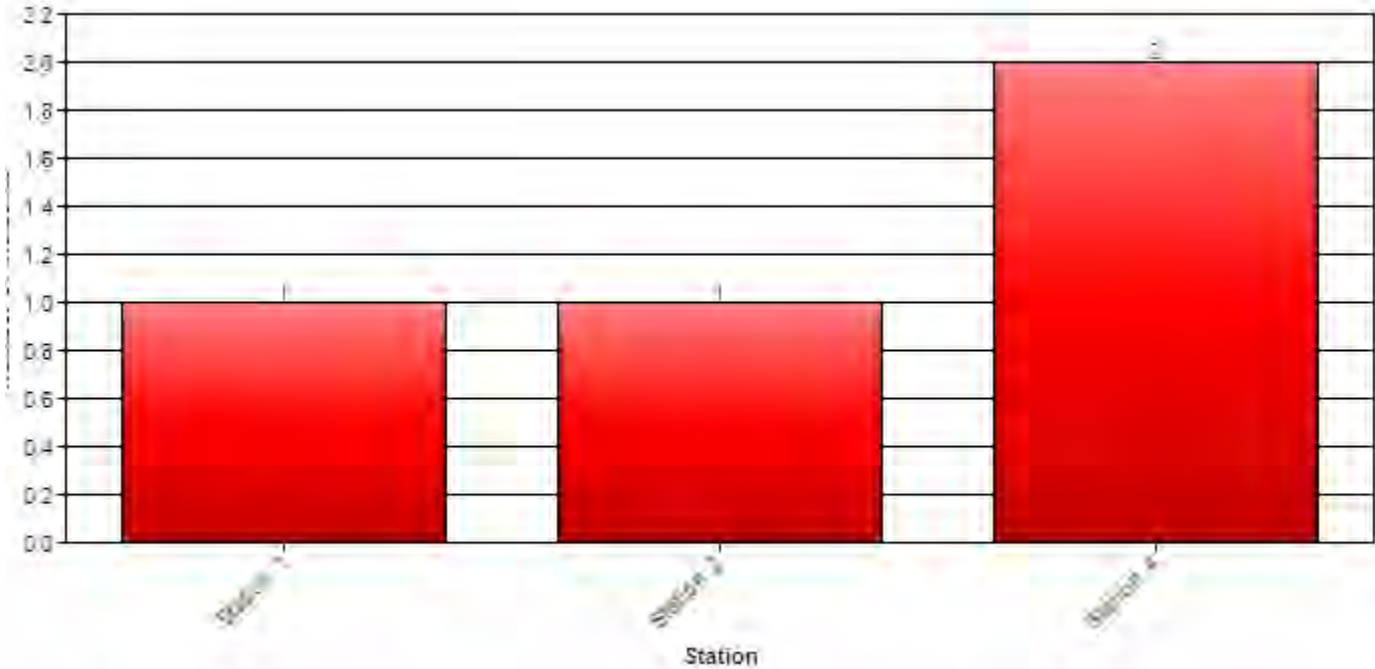

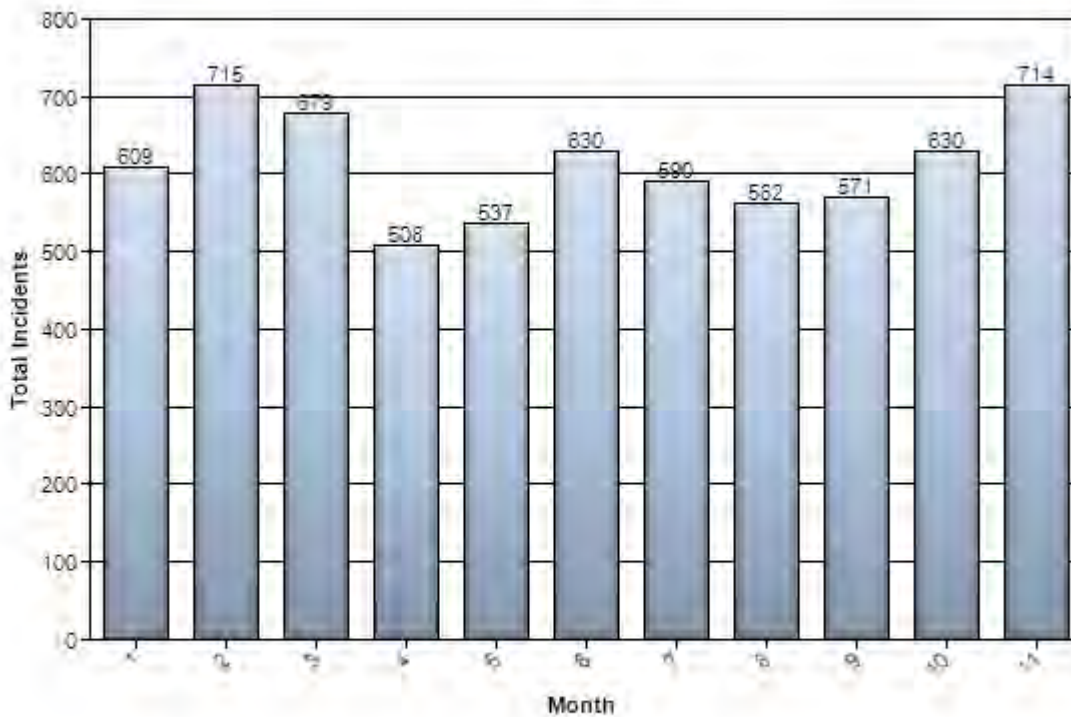
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### Incidents by Month - YTD

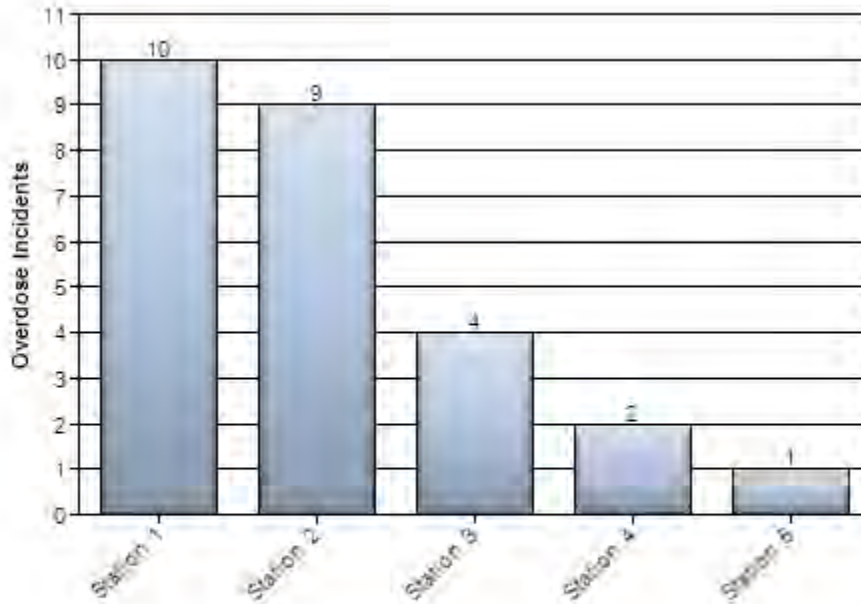

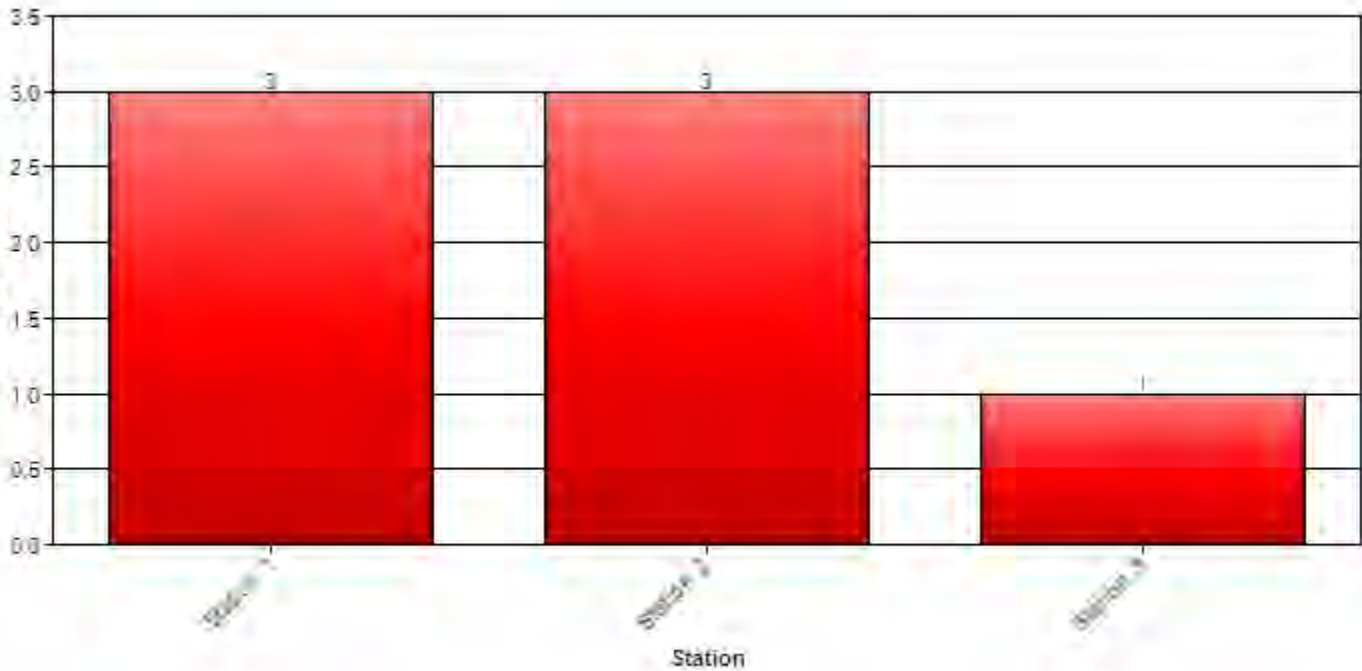

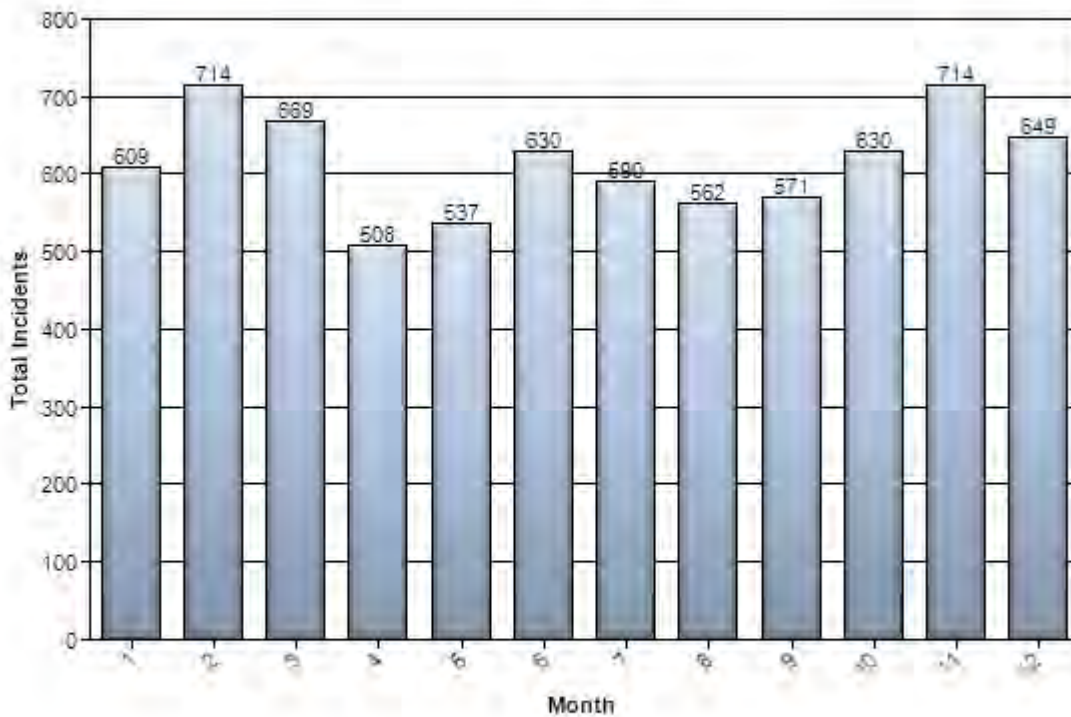
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### Incidents by Month - YTD

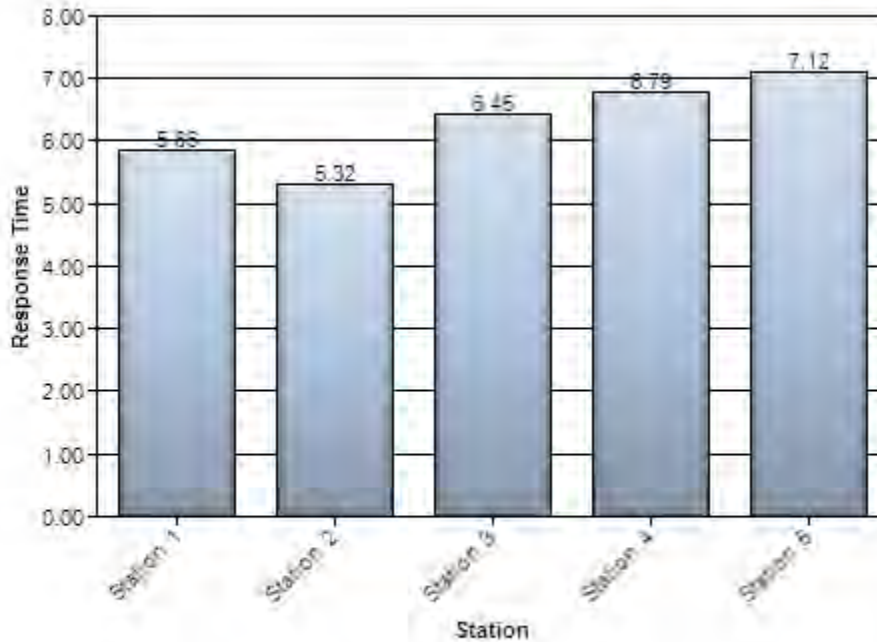

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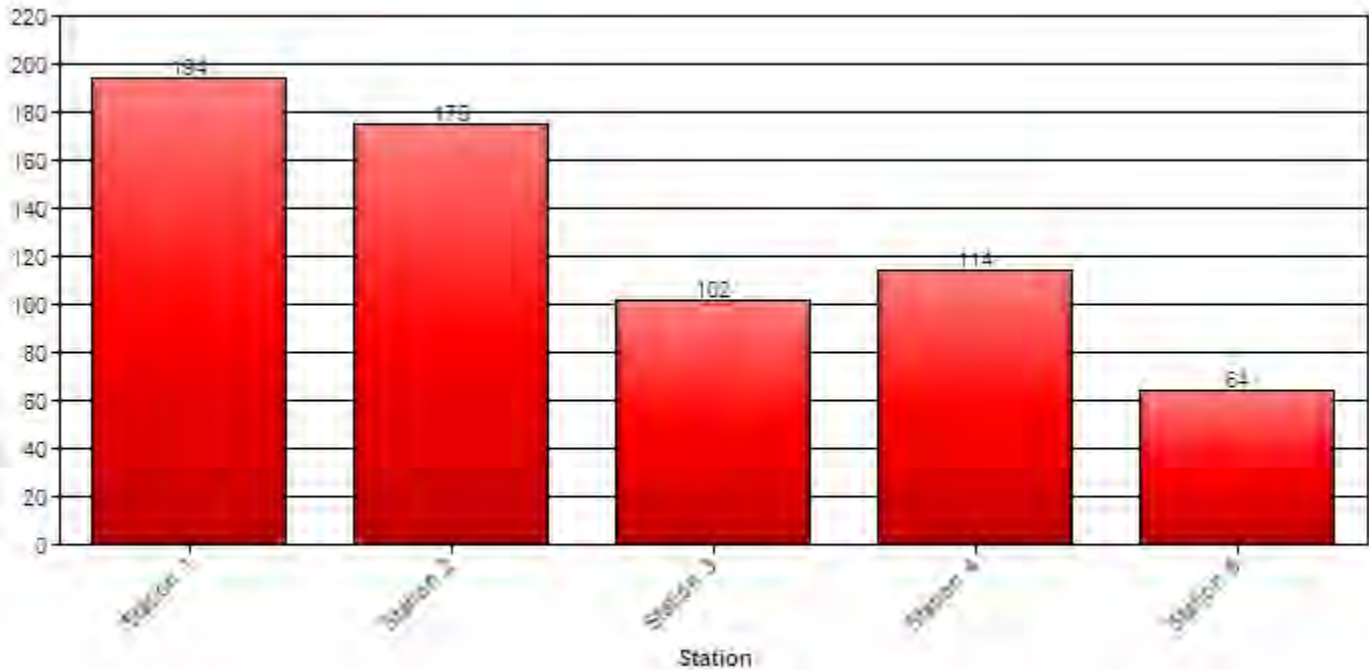
