**Call to Order**

Chairperson Marken called the public hearing to order at 5:04 p.m.

**Invocation/Pledge**

A moment of silence was observed. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Public Hearing/Adoption of 2021/2022 Non-Ad Valorem Fire Assessments**

- **Verification of Public Notice**  
Chairperson Marken called for verification of the Public Notice. EMA Tuckerman stated that the advertisement was completed as required and the affidavit has been received.
- **Presentation of Non-Ad Valorem Fire Assessment Rates**  
Chief Bounds presented the fire assessment rates. Rates increased by 4.36% as allowed.
- **Open Public Hearing for Comment**  
Chairperson Marken opened the Public Hearing for comments at 5:07 p.m. There were no comments.
- **Close the Public Hearing**  
*Commissioner Cena motioned to close the public hearing. Commissioner Grote seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.* Chairperson Marken closed the public hearing at 5:07 p.m.
- **Board Deliberation Resolution 2021-07**  
*Commissioner Grote motioned to approve Resolution 2021-07 Adopting the 2021/2022 Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Rates. Commissioner Evans seconded the motion, and the motion unanimously carried.*

The Public Hearing adjourned at 5:09 p.m.

**Public Hearing/Adoption of Resolution 2021-08 FY2022 Tentative Millage Rate**

- **Verification of Public Notice**  
Chairperson Marken called for verification of the Public Notice. EMA Tuckerman stated that the advertisement was completed as required and the affidavit has been received.

- **Presentation of Tentative Millage Rate/Procedures**  
Chief Bounds gave an overview of the millage rate. The 2021/2022 operating millage rate recommendation is 1.2061 mills, which is our current rate.
- **Open Public Hearing for Comment**  
Chairperson Marken opened the Public Hearing for comments at 5:10 p.m. There were no comments.
- **Close the Public Hearing**  
*Commissioner Evans motioned to close the public hearing. Commissioner Cena seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.* Chairperson Marken closed the public hearing at 5:11 p.m.
- **Board Deliberation Resolution 2021-08**  
*Commissioner Grote motioned to approve the fiscal year 2021/2022 operating millage rate for the Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District at 1.2061 mills which is higher than the rolled-back rate of 1.1557 mills by 4.36%. Commissioner Evans seconded the motion, and the motion unanimously carried.*

The Public Hearing adjourned at 5:13 p.m.

#### **Public Hearing/Adoption of FY2021/2022 Tentative Budget**

- **Verification of Public Notice**  
Chairperson Marken called for verification of the Public Notice. EMA Tuckerman stated that the advertisement was completed as required and the affidavit has been received.
- **Presentation of Tentative Budget/Procedures**  
Chief Bounds gave an overview of the 2021-2022 Tentative Budget.
- **Open Public Hearing for Comment**  
Chairperson Marken opened the Public Hearing for comments at 5:18 p.m. There were no comments.
- **Close the Public Hearing**  
*Commissioner Grote made a motion to close the public hearing. Commissioner Evans seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.* Chairperson Marken closed the public hearing at 5:20 p.m.
- **Board Deliberation Resolution 2021-09**  
Chairperson Marken opened Board deliberation on Resolution 2021-09. *Commissioner Evans made a motion to accept Resolution 2021-09. Commissioner Grote seconded the motion, and the motion unanimously carried.*
- **Adjournment of Public Hearing**  
Chairperson Marken adjourned the Public Hearing at 5:21 p.m.

Chairperson Marken stated the next meeting will be a Public Hearing and Regular meeting on Thursday, September 16 at 5 p.m. That meeting will be for the final adoption of the Millage Rate and Budget.
