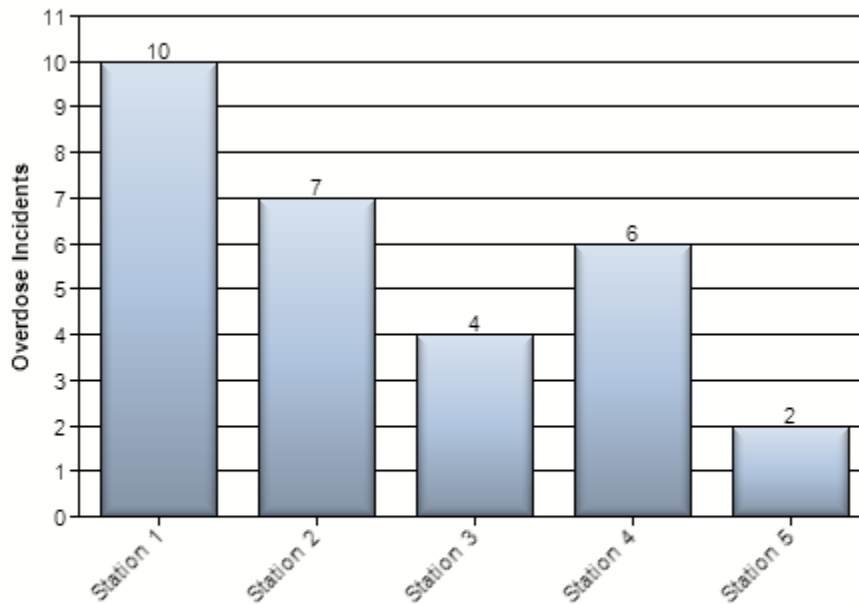

Alarm Date between 2022-02-01 and 2022-03-01



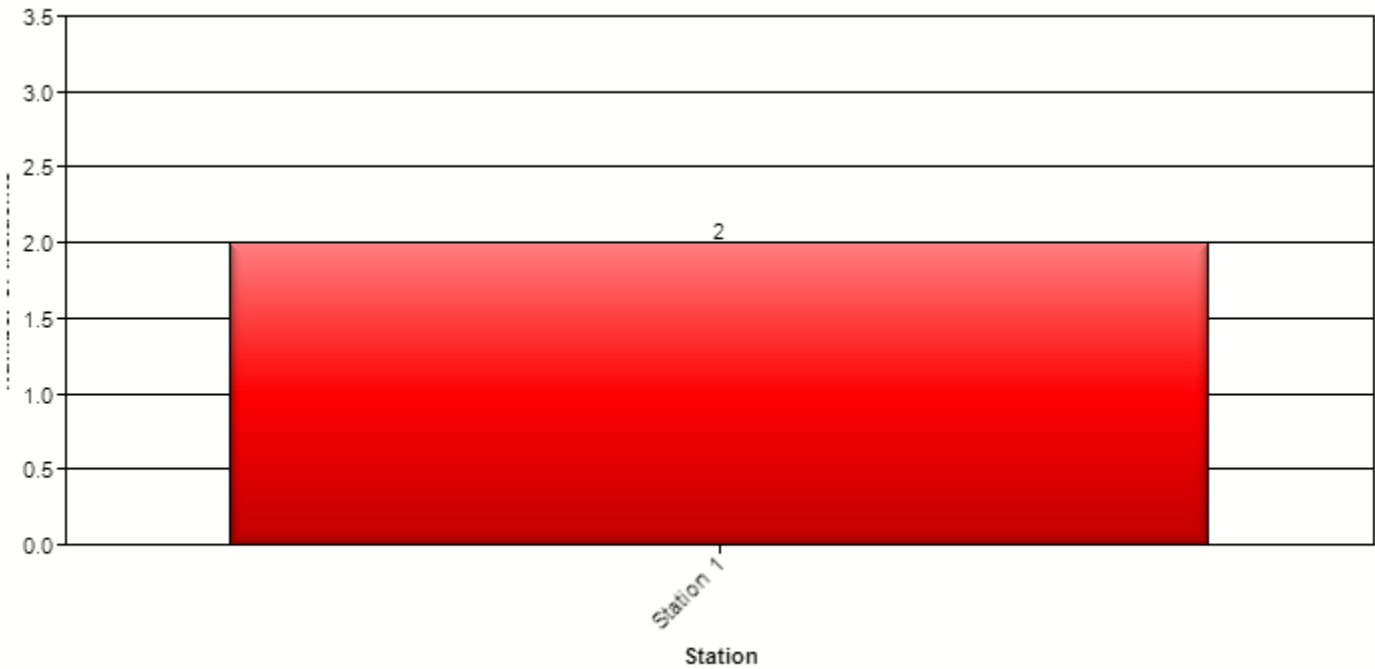

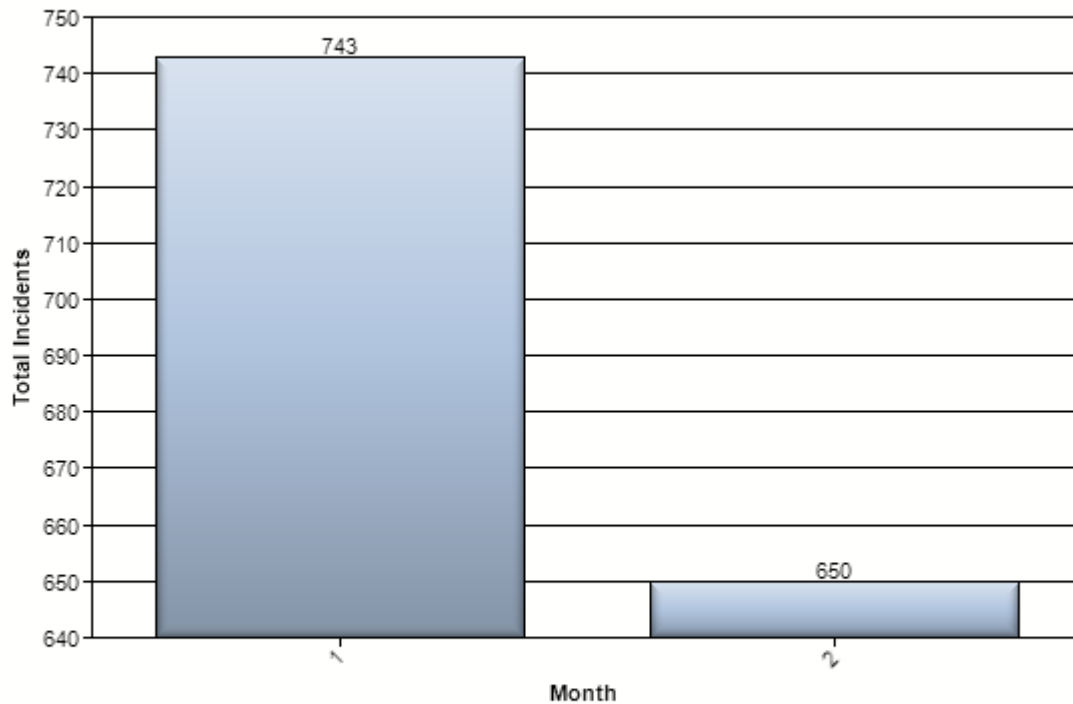


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Incidents by Month - YTD

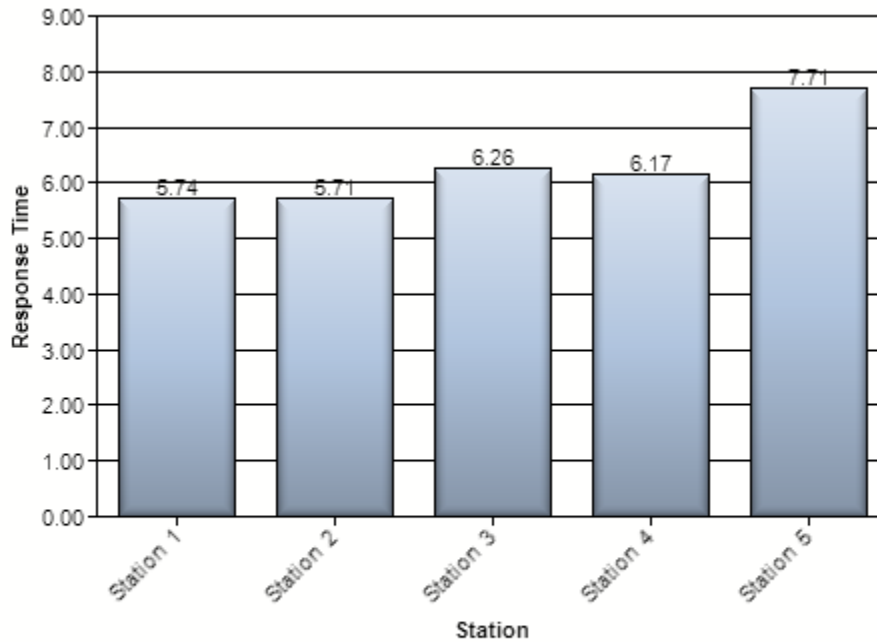

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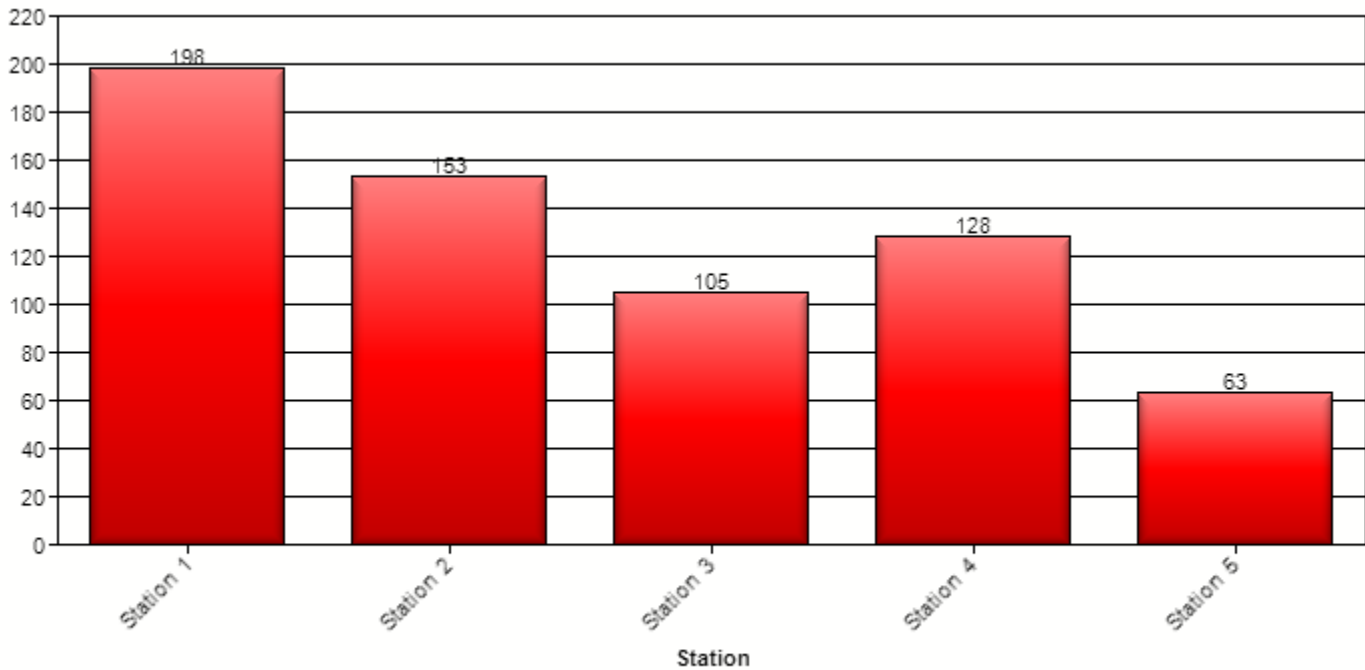
