#### RESOLUTION 2014 – 07 2014 MILLAGE RATE ADOPTION SOUTHERN MANATEE FIRE & RESCUE DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHERN MANATEE FIRE & RESCUE DISTRICT OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A MILLAGE RATE FOR THE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE SOUTHERN MANATEE FIRE & RESCUE DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, sets forth the requirements for fixing millage, levying ad valorem tax and noticing a public hearing on the adoption of a millage rate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners for the Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District of Manatee County, Florida, on September 10, 2014, conducted a duly noticed public hearing to consider the adoption of a millage rate for Fiscal Year 2014/2015;

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners for the Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District adopted a Fiscal Year 2014/2015 millage rate following the above referenced public hearing held pursuant to the requirements set forth in Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Manatee County has been certified by the Manatee County Property Appraiser to the Board of Fire Commissioners for the **Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District** as \$3,674,414,297.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District of Manatee County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated fully herein by reference.
- 2. The Fiscal Year 2014/2015 operating millage rate for the Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District is 1.2061 mills which is higher than the rolled-back rate of .9652 mills by 24.96%.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
