



Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, September 16, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard the Southern Manatee Board of Fire Commissioners will hold two (2) public hearings on the following: (1) the District's adoption of the 2021 Millage Rate and (2) the District's 2021/22 Fiscal Year Budget.

No stenographer needed by a certified court reporter is made of this meeting. If any person desires to appeal any decision of the Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District Board of Commissioners, that person will need to ensure that a written record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based (F.S. 256.0106).

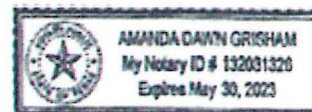
