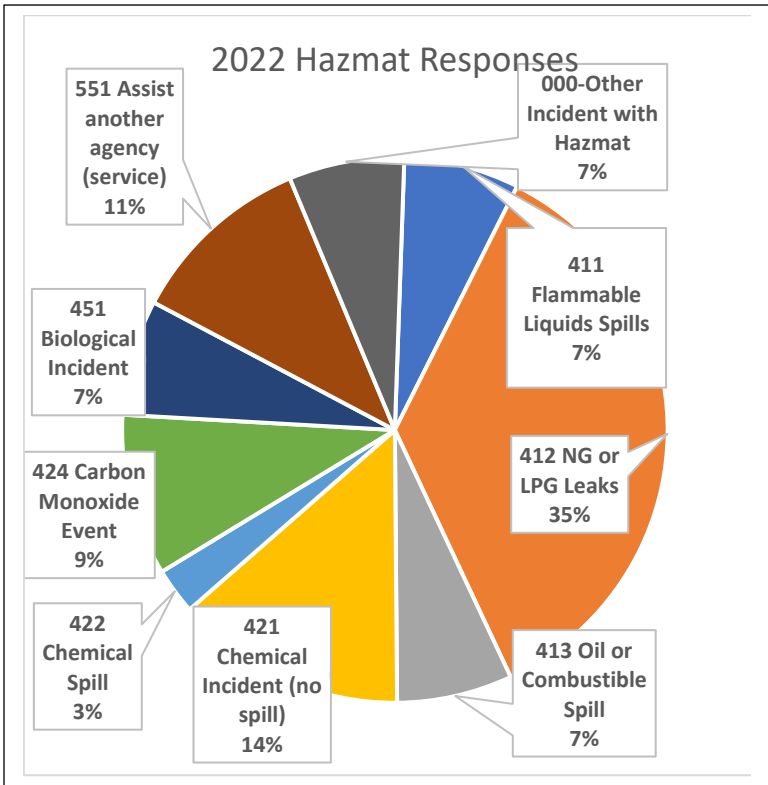

2022 SMFR Year to Date Hazmat Responses (M/A & In District): 73 or @ 10 responses per month

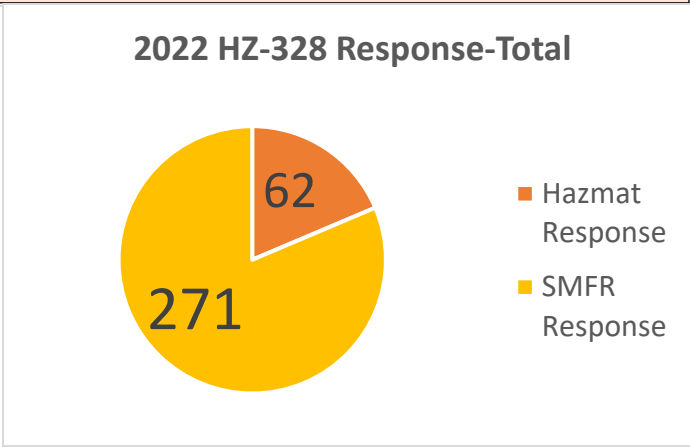
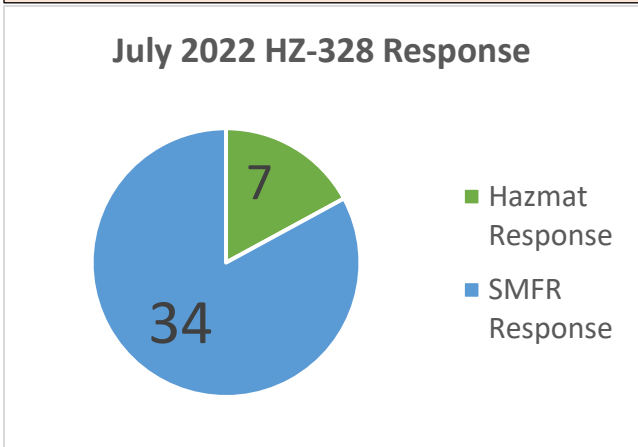
