WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners for the **Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District** of Manatee County, Florida, on September 7, 2023, conducted a duly noticed public meeting and hearing to consider the adoption of a tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2023 – 2024, as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners for the **Southern Manatee Fire & Rescue District** of Manatee County, Florida, set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2023 - 2024 in the amount of \$23,723,679.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.



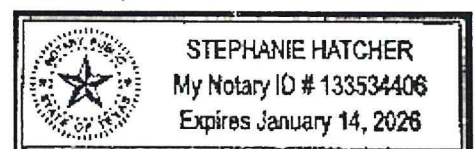
